The English Indices of Deprivation 2015 – ‘Health Deprivation and Disability’ Domain

Last updated: October 2015

Introduction

The Health Deprivation and Disability Domain measures the risk of premature death and the impairment of quality of life through poor physical or mental health. The domain measures morbidity, disability and premature mortality but not aspects of behaviour or environment that may be predictive of future health deprivation.

Indicators

The indicators used to calculate Health Deprivation and Disability include:

- Years of potential life lost
- Comparative illness and disability ratio
- Acute morbidity
- Mood and anxiety disorders

National comparison

There are no Island LSOAs among the 10% most deprived areas in England.

There are seven within the 20% most deprived:

- Parkhurst B
- Ventnor East A
- Pan B
- Pan A
- Ryde North East B
- Sandown North B
- Newport North B

At the opposite end of the scale, there are no Island LSOAs within the 10% least deprived in England and only one in the 20% least deprived:

- Bembridge North
